

WGC ART AWARD

- The competition is open to any student on the current roll at Wellington Girls' College, not just students taking Art as a subject.
- Entries can be submitted in any medium — painting, drawing, photography, sculpture, print, mixed media.
- Entries must be within the scale of A4-A2 (cubed).
- Students are expected to provide their own materials for the art work.
- The theme this year is '**Nurture**'. Entrants are encouraged to interpret this broadly.
- Pre-entries are due by 25 May to ann.gilbert@wgc.school.nz—purely to help us manage the process and how we will display the works.
- Entries will be due by the first day of Term 3. Entries will be received at the Reception desk on the last day of the Term 2 holidays and up until 8.45am on 23 July.
- Entries will be submitted anonymously but a sealed envelope must also be handed in for each entry with the completed entry form inside. This will be opened by the Principal's PA (Ann Gilbert), for administrative purposes but kept secret from the Judges.
- The Art department will undertake an initial check of the entries. If they feel there is no work worthy of receiving the award in a particular year, or if the works are not appropriate, they will not be judged.
- If the works are worthy of judging, an external panel will be invited to make the final decision as to the Winner and Highly Commended.
- All entries will be displayed in the Atrium from the time of initial checking up until the time of the announcement.
- The winners will be announced at a 5.00pm function to which all entrants, their families, sponsors, BOT and staff will be invited. This function will be hosted by the Arts committee, the Visual Art department and Principal.
- The winner will receive a cash prize of \$400, a certificate and also an acknowledgement on the Art Wall.
- The Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The winning art work will become the property of Wellington Girls' College and form part of the permanent art collection in the school. It will be displayed in the college up until the time the next award is made. It will also be able to be used by Wellington Girls' College in any promotional material (but must be attributed).
- The school may choose to enter into negotiations with any other entrant to buy their work.
